cooking, guided tours.**

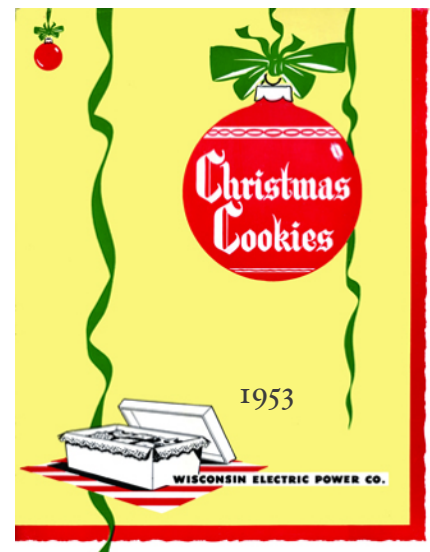
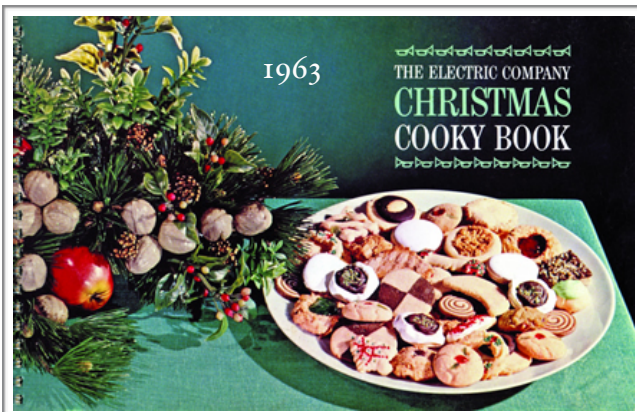
### ★ New this year ★

This full sized quilt in the Sunburst pattern was recently donated to the Hawks Inn collection by Amy Brazale and Christine Schenk, daughters of the late Ardith Brazale of Delafield. Once displayed as part of the Wisconsin Quilt History project, it was skillfully pieced in 1840 by Sarah Lee Losey.

Here is a sample of our annual costs:

...Alarm system.....	\$600.00
...Insurance .....	\$2,450.00
...Gas and Electric.....	\$3,000.00
...Telephone and Wi-Fi* .....	\$1,500.00
...*The alarm system requires two telephone lines.	
...Sewer and Water .....	\$750.00

In addition, there are ongoing maintenance, repairs, supplies, postage and printing costs. Coming up are outside painting and Visitor Center floor maintenance.
